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General Club Policies

General Course Rules

Course guidelines are as follows. The Golf Shop can provide a more detailed summary:

- When carrying a bag or using a pull cart, do not place the bag or cart on the greens or aprons.
- Fix all ball marks on the greens. Replace divots in fairways, and rough and rake all sand traps. Please use supplied divot mix to fill in fairway divots.
- Members are responsible for any damage done to carts caused by them.
- Children under 16 years of age are not allowed to operate carts, although they may ride in carts with an adult as long as no more than two people occupy the cart at any time.
- Pitching, chipping, and sand shots are permitted only toward the practice green.
- To protect our members, guests and neighbors from errant shots on the practice range, only restricted flight balls may be used. The Club provides PGA-approved restricted flight balls, please see the Golf Shop if you have questions.
- The Head Golf Professional will establish and enforce where only irons may be used.

Dress Code

Proper attire shall be worn on the practice range, putting green and golf course. Proper attire is outlined as follows:

- For men, collared shirts and Bermuda-length shorts are minimally acceptable attire. For women, golf attire normally sold in the Golf Shop including tops, pants, Bermuda-length shorts and skirts are considered minimally acceptable attire.
- Shirttails must be tucked in. Caps must be worn bill-forward.
- Examples of *inappropriate* golf attire include: short shorts, tee shirts, undershirts, tank tops, dungarees, cargo pants or shorts, designer jeans*, jeans* and denim*. The Head Golf Professional or their designee is authorized to enforce the dress code.
- Race Brook Country Club is a soft spike facility; no metal spikes are allowed. Golf shoes may only be worn on the lower level of the clubhouse.
- Members are responsible for informing their guests in advance of the Club's dress code.

*Addendum: The new policy states that jeans may be worn any weekday for lunch or dinner, and any event where the Club specifies jeans are permitted. They may never be worn on the golf course, range, or putting green.

Cell Phone and Mobile Device Usage Policy:

- Cell phones may be used for texting, email, or internet so long as no sound is emitted in the process. Verbal communication is limited to locker rooms, parking lot, and business center. Use is permitted on the Patio and Deck only when food service is not being provided.
- Cell phones must be maintained in silent or vibrate modes. Retrieval of voice messages is permitted.
- Verbal use of cell phones on the golf courses is only permitted to inform the Golf Shop of slow play or a medical emergency.
